Subject: Terms of Reference (TOR) to empanel and engage Retired Senior Scientists as Consultants from Government or Govt. approved Institutes on contract basis.

1. About the Institute

- State Forest Research Institute, Jabalpur (SFRI) came into existence on 27th June, 1963 for the scientific development of forestry sector in the state of Madhya Pradesh following the recommendations of tenth Silvicultural Conference held at Dehradun in 1961.
- 1.2. It was granted autonomy on 29th October, 1994 and was registered on 2nd August, 1995 as a society under M.P. Societies Registration Act 1973.
- 1.3. Over the years the institute has developed as an educational, training, research and consultancy organization at the state and national level and is carrying out adaptive and applied research programmes.
- 1.4. The research programmes are focused on tropical forestry, environment, wildlife, agro forestry, biotechnology and biodiversity conservation.
- 1.5. The vision of SFRI is to function as nodal centre of research in forestry and to provide scientific support to the state and its people on matters related to forestry, wildlife and climate change with particular emphasis on conservation, sustainable utilization and scientific management of natural resources.
- 1.6. The institute is located at Jabalpur in a lush green campus spread over a sprawling area of about 102 ha.

2. Purpose of Contract Research Program

- 2.1. To meet the requirement of shortage of senior scientists at SFRI. It is proposed to empanel and then engage senior scientists who have retired from Govt. and Govt. approved private institutions through the screening process of SFRI.
- 2.2. Enhancement of research quality at the Institute by utilizing the experience of senior retired scientists.
- 2.3. Enhancement of quality research activity at the Institute.
- 2.4. Scientific and technical up gradation of newly appointed project staff and the staff of S.F.R.I.

3. Contract Research Program (CRP)

- 3.1. The main focus of the Contract Research Program (CRP) is to empanel and engage senior scientists as consultants, retired from Govt. and Govt. approved private institutions through the screening process of the institution.
- 3.2. The empanelled scientists will be required to present the concept note of at least three research proposals to the screening committee/RAC of SFRI in the prescribed format (ANNEXURE –II).
- 3.3. These empanelled scientists (consultants), will then be asked to submit the Detailed Project Proposals (DPP) of the approved concept note of projects within a prescribed period of not more than three months and lump-sum honorarium of Rs. 25000.00 will be provided.
- 3.4. Upon approval of DPP from the funding agency, the scientists will be engaged on contract basis on the rates approved by the Board of Governors (BOG) of SFRI and the research will be carried out by the scientist within the stipulated time frame.

4. How to Apply?

Online applications are invited from retired scientist (upper age limit 65 years) from Government Research Institutes or Govt. approved Institutes to carry out research work under the "Contract research program" of the Institute. The interested candidates, in good physical health and possessing the required qualifications, may send their completely filled Application form (ANNEXURE-I) to The Director, State Forest Research Institute, Jabalpur by e-mail only to mpsfri@mp.gov.in before 21/03/2022

Received applications will be scrutinized by the committee and selected candidates will be called for the interview as per information along with original testimonials, certificates etc. of their educational qualifications, work experiences etc. and a self attested copy thereof for verification and finalization of TOR.

This post is purely temporary and the tenure will be limited according to approved project proposal only. The project period will be extended further if funding agency permits and extends the project tenure, subject to the need of the Institute and satisfactory performance.

- A Screening-cum-Selection Committee shall be constituted by the Director of the Institute for empanelment of Retired Senior Scientists.
- The Committee shall consist of following members mentioned below: -

- On the basis of approval of project concept notes, the candidate will be asked to submit the Detailed Project Proposal (DPP) based on the approved concept note and will be provided with the lump-sum grant of Rs.25000.00 for preparation of the Detailed Project Proposal (DPP)

- The selected Retired Senior Scientist will then be appointed by contract as Principal Investigator when the submitted project proposal will be sanctioned by the funding agency.
